The roofing contractor is waiting on some good weather to start replacement of the Cornerstone Building and education wing roofs.

Mary and Terry continue to work with our ELCA sister congregations about possibly partnering in the future. I expect our (hopefully) new interim pastor will join in the effort. Please continue to pray for them and give them your support. They are always open to discussions and will report to the congregation as necessary.


