Dear People of God at Faith Lutheran Church,

On Pentecost Sunday, June 8th, together with Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, we will commit to beginning a blending process. A process is a series of actions and steps taken to achieve a set goal. Process is a journey. The Blending for Mission work we are entering into will lead to a point (December or January) in which both congregations will have votes that will be "yay" or "nay." Yes to blend together to become one congregation, or no, and go separate ways.

This process will include listening to God, listening to each other, and listening to the world. During this time you will have opportunities to get to know each other, individually and corporately. It is very important that we take the time, resolutely, employing discernment, prayer and trust that the Holy Spirit is active in this process, this journey, this reality.

There are more than 16 congregations in the Oregon Synod that wish for a part time pastor. I can tell you honestly, there are very few pastors interested in part time ministry. That is considered survival mode. And even at part time, what these congregations can afford is not equal to half-time pay with benefits. This includes Faith Lutheran. Even with the preschool area rented out, we don't know if the Cornerstone building will have renters right away, later this summer.

With 20-25 people in worship on a given Sunday, Faith is not really holding on. Below you will find a graphic for the Congregation Life Cycle. Each circle represents the amount of energy that it will take to stabilize. Many of you know that there isn't the energy to turn things around. There is no blame pointed anywhere. This is the natural cycle of life for congregations, organizations, businesses, and people. Yet this time is giving you an opportunity. (continued on page 2)


The beloved passage from Ecclesiastes 3 helps us realize this reality:

For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven:

A time to be born, and a time to die;

- a time to plant, and a time to pluck up what is planted;
- a time to kill, and a time to heal;
- a time to break down, and a time to build up;
- a time to weep, and a time to laugh;
- a time to mourn, and a time to dance:
- a time to throw away stones, and a time to gather stones together;
- a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing;
- a time to seek, and a time to lose;
- a time to keep, and a time to throw away;
- a time to tear, and a time to sew;
- a time to keep silence, and a time to speak;
- a time to love, and a time to hate;
- a time for war, and a time for peace.

What if this is a time to plant? What if this is a time to gather stones together to build a new, vibrant congregation with Good Shepherd? What if this is a time to break down in order to build up? What if it is time to sew together something new? What if it is time to let go so that you can take hold? What time is the Holy Spirit saying it is at Faith Lutheran?

Time has two differing words in Greek: Chronos for chronological time; and Kairos, for God's time, for the opportune moment, for God's perfect time breaking into Chronos time. We are in Kairos time, when the Spirit invites us into God's perfect timing. That doesn't make things easier. It is a "carpe diem" moment—seize the day!

You still need to identify what to let go of and what to take hold of during this Chronos time and process. Be assured that the process is within God's Kairos timing. As the Spirit calls, take hold of the steadfast love of God. Look to the Lord who is our Rock and Redeemer. Consider what really matters in this Kairos moment. Remember the ways God has been faithful throughout Faith's 75 years of ministry.

When I have been wary of the next thing for me, I have been able (mostly) to remember God's faith-fulness and to trust God's grace to carry me as I face change, opportunity, new life. Oh, I stumble at times. Maybe being an Interim Pastor is part of my continued learning to trust God and begin to see again the Kairos moments as they come. Exciting and a little scary.

Dear Faith Lutheran, you continue to be in my prayers during this time as I continue to walk with you in this process, to assist the Spirit's guidance and call to a future being revealed even now. This is a time to dream dreams and see visions of what the Spirit of God is up to with the two congregations.

Enter into God's Kairos time and believe that the future is filled with God's dreams and visions with you.

Swallowed, absorbed, integrated, blended. All of these words have crossed my mind as I've been participating in the 'Blending for Mission' process. And frankly, some of these words worry me. Good Shepherd has 3 times as many members as we do, of course it's going to feel like they are just swallowing up the members of Faith. When we get the two congregations together for worship it's always at Good Shepherd. Are they just slowly absorbing us into their congregation?

I pray about this all the time and try hard to hear what God is telling us to do, and trusting that he is leading us down the right path. And I know he is! I know that even though some of my thoughts are scary, I know we are going to *blend* as two congregations, coming together as *equals*, and following the mission that he is leading us towards.

These next few months are critical. Faith MUST stay engaged with the process, even when there are doubts. Everyone's voice must be heard, even if it's hard truths, or makes us feel sad.

On June 8th we will meet at Good Shepherd for worship and a joint Congregational meeting. This is where we will make a formal commitment to walk this road together. We will start the listening process with groups one-on-one, two-on-two, then four-on-four. Members from both congregations will start scheduling their listening sessions with internal partners (that's me and you) and with external partners, which will take place over the summer. These sessions will give you the chance to share your thoughts, hopes, and dreams.

The council and Pastor Dorthy are highly committed to this process and are happy to answer any questions you may have. I will do my best to keep our members informed as we move along.

'Tis bliss to have the poet's heart That loves the quietude of things, Where nature smiles her bidden rocks, And brings out sweet and cooling springs.


The June-green grass beneath my feet, The dandelion's disk of gold, The corn's slim spire just pushing out From clean brown beds of kindly mold.
