Dear People of God at Faith Lutheran,

Advent season is here. The first candle has been lit, and we wait, and watch, and be ready. Ready for what? Ready for who? For the coming of Christ our Savior, our Teacher, our Brother.

Advent is a time of being ready for this Divine One who continuously reaches out to us, calling, inviting, revealing, loving. Advent begins a new cycle of hearing the God speak through our Scriptures, as well as through music, friends, and other means. It is not beyond God to even use what we might question as a reliable source of God's voice.

Sometimes I hear God's voice in the robin's call, or my dog's welcome home wags, or a card from a loved one. God speaks to us in all kinds of ways, and enlightens us with grace unbound. The children, Jane and Michael, wanted Mary to stay forever, but she said she would only stay until the wind changes direction. At her leaving the children's parents began to have a new relationship with them, something closer and engaged. They no longer needed a nanny. The family grew together.

In the season of Advent, and in this time of change, we are sensing that the winds are changing direction. That means my work is finished among you and it is time for me to leave. Now you enter into a new chapter, a new time in your ministry, this time with Pr Cindy and Good Shepherd, our siblings in Christ Jesus. This builds the Kingdom of God here in Albany, and especially as you begin to envision the mission God is calling both congregations.

Thank you for these 21 months together. You are now part of my spiritual DNA, and I will hold you in my heart and prayers as you begin this new time. It is Advent for you, anticipating the ways God will speak to you, invite you to engage with Good Shepherd and the Albany community in new ways. In this new reality for you is God, who has been faithful in 75 years. God has always been with you and will continue to be.

As Christmas draws near, we remember the only God, Who came in the vulnerability of flesh and blood, Who loves beyond measure, and is always with us.
